In 1993 SFMG created a computerised network of general practitioners,




to validate a "medical consultation's results dictionary" in general practice, compose of 269 definitions

allowed a knowledge of the contents of real medical general practice in France

# 55 495 different patients were taken care of.





during 176 123 medical sessions.

Visits: 18.76% of the sessions

The females represent 53% of the patients and asked 56% of the sessions


The average number of the sessions per patient increased with the age. from 3.63 to 6.32 sessions per year.

# 317 080 health problems were analyzed
